ADMISSION PROCESS

How to obtain Application Form

- **IN PERSON:**

Application can be obtained from College Office in the Second week of April every year between 10:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. on all working days on payment of Rs.250 for a UG Course and Rs. 300 for a PG Course. Candidates should use separate application form for the different branches/courses they seek admission.

- **BY POST :**

Sending a Demand Draft with a requisition letter addressed to Principal, D.B.Jain College, Thoraiakkam, Chennai – 600097, along with a self-addressed envelope (23*13 cm) affixed with Rs.60 postal stamp.

- **ONLINE :**

Application forms also can be downloaded from college website www.dbjaincollege.org

How to Submit Application Form

- Filled-in application form for all UG Courses with a latest color (with white background) passport-size photograph affixed in the box provided should be submitted to College Office within TEN DAYS from the date of publication of TamilNadu Higher Secondary Examination results. At the time of registration, the candidate must have completed 16 years 6 months on 1st July of the year of Admission.
- Filled-in application form for all PG Courses with a latest color (with white background) passport-size photograph affixed in the box provided should be submitted to Shift- II College Office within TEN DAYS from the date of publication of University Under-Graduate Examination results.

- Acknowledgement Card should be collected at the time of registration of the application form in person.
- Attested PHOTOCOPIES of the following documents (with the application number written on each document) should be appended to the duly filled-in application form :
 1. Plus- Two Marks Statement issued by the appropriate authority
 2. Transfer Certificate / Conduct Certificate
 3. Community Certificate (BC/MBC/DNC/SC/ST)
 4. Certificate of Proof in the case of Differently-able candidates/ Candidates with Sport/NCC credentials/Wards of Ex-Servicemen.
 5. X Standard Marks Statement for SC/ST students for applying for Government Scholarship.
 6. Eligibility Certificate from the University of Madras in case candidates belong to Boards other than Tamil Nadu State Board.
 7. Marks Statement along with Provisional/Degree Certificate issued by the University in case of candidates applying for Postgraduate Courses.
 8. Recognition Certificate obtained from the University of Madras in case candidates have graduated from Universities other than the University of Madras.
 9. Aadhar Card photocopy.
 10. Blood Group Report.
- Duly filled-in application form can also be sent by post to Principal, D.B.Jain College, Thoraipakkam, and Chennai – 600097. A self-addresses envelope affixed with Rs.6.00 postal stamp should be appended to the application form to enable the College Office to send the acknowledgement card. Please note that the College Office will not be responsible for any postal delay.
- Incomplete application forms will not be taken into consideration.
- In all communications related to admission, the application number must be quoted.
- In case application form is downloaded, the cost of application form should be remitted at the time of registration.

Provisional Selection and Intimation

- After scrutiny of the application forms, provisionally selected candidates will be sent Interview Cards to the address furnished on the Card.

- Requests for extension of date and time of Interview will not be entertained. The provisional selection will automatically stand cancelled in case the candidate's fails to appear for interview on the date and time mentioned on the Interview Card.
- For admission to Post-graduate courses, an entrance test followed by a personal interview will be conducted. Based on the performance, candidates will be intimated of their provisional selection.

Interview and Admission

- The provisionally selected candidates will have to present themselves along with their parent / guardian for an interview with the Principal on the date time mentioned on the Interview Card.
- Provisionally selected candidates shall bring all ORIGINAL certificates and documents at the time of interview for verification. 2 sets of photocopies of these certificates and documents shall also be handed over to the college office. In addition, 3 latest color (with white background) passport-size photographs, 1 passport-size photograph of the candidate's father, mother, guardian (for Mentoring Records) shall also be provided.
- The Transfer Certificate has to be submitted in original only. No other original certificate needs to be submitted to the college.
- Candidates attending the Interview should be prepared to remit the Semester Course Fees immediately on the intimation of their selection. The amount of Semester Course Fess will be indicated on the Interview Card.

Mode of Payment of Fees

- College Course Fees shall be remitted by the candidates through Easy Pay in Axis Bank.
- Non-payment of Semester Course Fees on the day of admission will automatically lead to cancellation of admission and the seat will be allotted to the next eligible candidate.

Withdrawal from Course

- A student once enrolled for a course is expected to complete the same.
- The student shall not withdraw from the course without informing Principal in writing.

- In case the student withdraws from the course without completing the same, he/she is liable to pay the fees for the period his/her name remains on the College rolls.

EVALUATION PROCESS

The Controller of Examinations is in charge of the examination process in the College. The Examination Cell provides support to the Controller of Examination. The institution has an Examination Manual which clearly states the rules and regulations of the evaluation process. The rules are strictly followed. To ensure transparency in the conduct of examinations an External Superintendent appointed to supervise all matters related to the conduct of Examination. The Exam Squad and Malpractice Prevention Committee ensure transparency and check on malpractices in the evaluation process. Double Valuation for the P.G Programmes ensures minimum anomalies in the valuation process. Provision is made for revaluation at the UG/PG level and re-counting of answer scripts at UG/PG Level.

RESEARCH, INNOVATIONS AND EXTENSION

- This Criterion has scored reasonably good grades due to the efforts of the college to promote research & facilities and for research publications & Awards.
- The research culture will have to be developed even in the UG classes as these will facilities in depth understanding of the subjects.
- An extension activity carries Maximum weightage in the criterion. Hence, efforts can be taken to develop Extension activities.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND LEARNING RESOURCES

The Library housing 40,452 volume books and over 30 lakhs of e-books from N-list sources, 72 printed journals and more than 5000 e-journals from INFLIBNET for the benefit of students, research scholars and faculty members. Books for Civil Services Examinations, Banking Recruitment exams, TOEFL, NET, SLET, TNPSC, RRB etc., are available. Membership in British Council division, and MALIBNET. The library offers Internet access free of cost and reprographic facilities to faculty and Student's. The Book Bank facility is also available for the needy students. A mini video hall available in the library with LCD projector facility.

Well-furnished computer centre, with five laboratories and 350 computers exclusively for students; computing centre's with internet enabled computers to serve the day-to-day computing needs of students with latest software.

The Department of Visual Communication is now housed in a well-designed building 'School of Media Studies' with Drawing & Painting Studio, Photograph and Video graph Floors, Edit Suited and a Recording Theatre.

The Physical Education Department maintains the ground for both indoor and outdoor games, well maintained ground for various outdoor games Kabaddi, Volley Ball, Ball Badminton, Foot Ball, Basket Ball, Kho Kho, Tennis, Cricket and indoor games like Chess, Table Tennis and Badminton.

Coaches for various games and sports are made available for the students by the Physical Education Department. The sports students avail financial and technical support from the college sports funds to participate in the University, State and National Level tournaments. The Physical Education Department maintains a well equipped gym for the students and staff.

The yoga classes conducted regularly with the help of well trained outside trainers for staff and students separately.

The sports ground of the College is also used for conducting University, State and National Level tournaments both boys and girls.

Sir Champalal Savansukha Auditorium has a seating capacity of 700. It is fully Air-conditioned and its light and sound system is currently being revamped. The Auditorium hosts various academic and cultural functions of the college.



- S.Nandhakumar III B.Com, Secured Gold Medal in the 8th Rural National Games Boxing Championship held at Haryana on 02.02.2019.
