The College follows student centric learning methods for effective curriculum delivery a detail unit wise plan for experiential and participative learning adapted for enhancing the learning experiences of the students. The college is incorporate more different modes for continuous internal evaluation. Program Outcome, Program Specific Outcomes and Course Outcomes are described in the syllabus. The attainment of the learning outcomes to be evaluated properly. All the departments conduct internal examination as per requirement of the affiliating University. The college has ICT enabled class room with LCD projector and smart class room.

The library, IQAC NAAC room and IT facilities like lab, WIFI and visual communication studio are also excellent. Many CCTV are installed in various locations for safety and security purposes.

strategies are to be re-tuned to empower the faculty members. the junior faculty members may be encouraged to attend faculty development program organized by other institutions and also the department may conduct such program to improve qualities of the teachers.

#### F. Students support and Progression

Several Departments conduct capacity building and skill enhancement activities for the students. Placement of the students and progression to higher education, though limited, are encouraging. Students need more encouragement for participation in extra-curricular activities.
