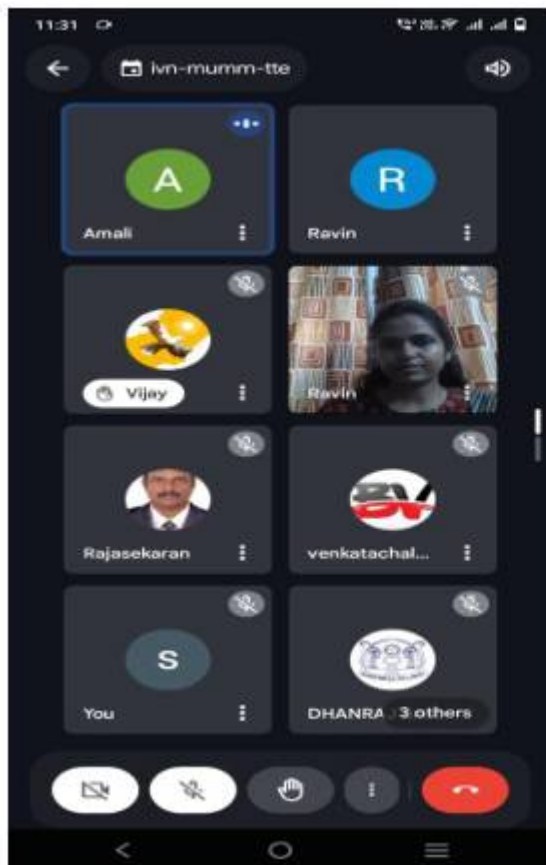

The industrial visit to **Masco Tea Factory** in Vagamon, Kerala, provided an enriching hands-on learning experience for the students, bridging the gap between theoretical knowledge and real-world industrial practices. Upon arrival, students were introduced to the sprawling tea plantations of the Idukki district and briefed on the factory's history as a unit of the **Malanad Co-operative Tea Factory**. The guided tour allowed participants to witness the systematic stages of tea manufacturing, including **plucking, withering, rolling, oxidation, and drying**. Factory experts explained how modern machinery transforms fresh green leaves into refined tea powder while maintaining strict quality control and hygiene standards. Students observed the grading process, where tea is categorized into various dust and leaf varieties based on size and quality. The visit also highlighted the factory's commitment to sustainability and its role in supporting local farmers through cooperative models. Interactive sessions with the staff offered insights into the economic challenges and market dynamics of the global tea industry. Many students also visited the factory outlet, where they learned about product packaging and retail distribution. The serene environment of the Western Ghats added a scenic dimension to the educational trip, making it a memorable outing. Overall, the trip was highly successful in fulfilling its academic objectives, leaving the students motivated and better informed about large-scale food processing operations.
