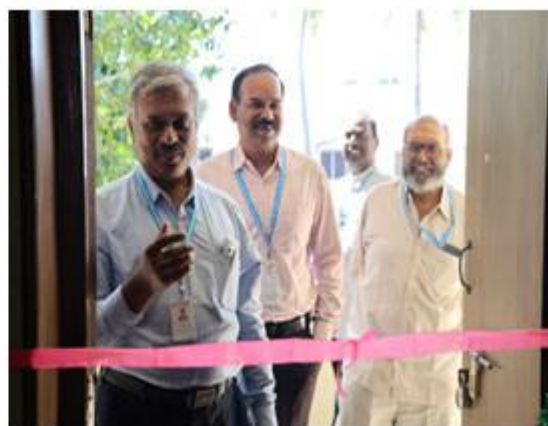
ICT PROGRAM -IBM COURSE Event Report

Communal Feast: The event concluded with the distribution of freshly prepared sweet Pongal and sugarcane to all attendees, strengthening the bond within the department.





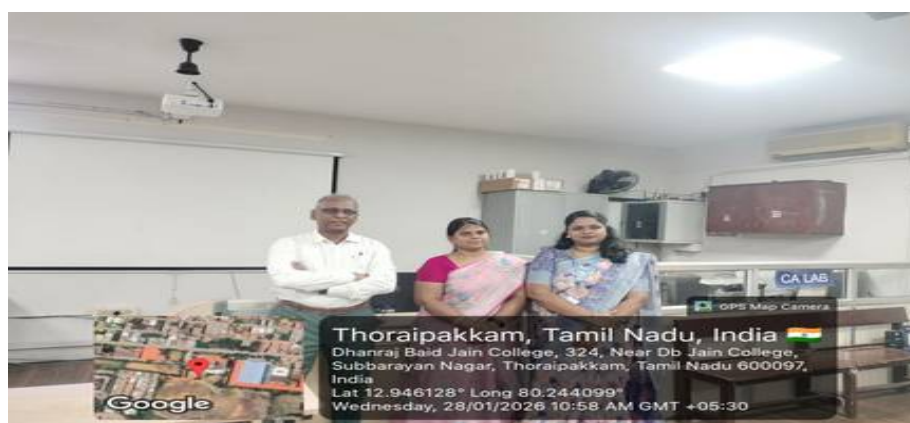
