### **Outcome of Day 1 FDP:**



Finally, the session was ended with the VOTE OF THANKS speech given by Miss. Monica, Computer Science Department.







# **Outcome of Day 2 FDP:**



At the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> day session the vote of thanks was given by Prof. Miss. Monika











The session was started with the introduction and welcome address of resource person Dr. D. Akila SadheeshKumar by Mrs. S. Bhuvaneswari. Dr. Akila started the session by discussing about 'research' and 'thesis'. During the session, Dr. Akila talked about the general guidelines to be adhered upon before starting a thesis.

Some key points to be noted here are:

- 1. Consult your supervisors.
- 2. Familiarize yourself with the style or format of thesis writing.
- 3. Decide on the word length.
- 4. Learn about your referencing styles.
- 5. Make sure you have all the necessary information for the reference section.
- 6. Learn about indexing your thesis.

Dr. Akila also gave few pointers or tips on the following topics:

- 1. Tips for writing the Introduction.
- 2. How to write your problem statement.
- 3. Contribution of your research Significance and ways to measure Significance.

Then, Dr. Akila, touched upon Literature review and briefed the audience about how to leverage previous research and the important questions to be asked while conducting a literature review.

Then Dr. Akila discussed how to write Research methodology, how to present the results in the Results section and how to write the Conclusion. Also the audiences were brought to attention about Plagiarism and how to avoid it while writing their thesis. The day 4 of the FDP was very unique and resourceful for all the participants who were satisfied with content delivered by the resource person. From her detailed articulation a strong thesis statement address specific intellectual questions, have clear points, and use a structure that indicates the general structure of the paper. It relies on one's ability to conduct research from start to finish. Referencing style, length, format of thesis writing is some of the guidelines one has to concentrate when writing the thesis.

The art of writing thesis efficiently is the core of any research. Thesis should be constructed so that they are specific and direct to the point. 





The day 5 of the online FDP started with the introduction of resource person Dr. S. Sasikala by Mrs. M. Rengalakshmi.

Dr. Sasikala opened the Day 5 session on Tools and Techniques of Research Methodology by explaining briefly on what are the tools, knowledge transfer and how creative AI can be leveraged for research methodology.

Some key points that were discussed in relation to Creative and Generative AI were:

- ➤ Creative AI: ability to create new content, such as images, music, and text that closely resembles human-created content by leveraging techniques like deep learning and neural networks.
- ➤ Generative AI- realistic and novel outputs, pushing the boundaries of machine creativity; Creating high quality text, graphics and videos, new user interfaces.
- Dr. Sasikala also demonstrated use cases of generative AI as given below:
- a. Implementing the chatbots for customer service and technical support.
- b. Deploying deep fakes for mimicking people or even specific individuals.
- c. Improving dubbing for movies and educational content in different languages.
- d. Writing email responses, dating profiles, resumes and term papers.
- e. Creating photorealistic art in a particular style.
- f. Improving product demonstration videos.
- g. Suggesting physical products and buildings.
- h. Optimizing new chip designs.
- i. Writing music in a specific style or tone.

Dr. Sasikala also talked about the benefits of Generative AI such as

- Automating the manual process of writing content
- Reducing the effort of responding to emails
- Improving the response to specific technical queries

The branch of artificial intelligence known as "generative AI" is concerned with developing models and algorithms that may generate fresh and unique content. Generative AI algorithms apply probabilistic approaches to produce new instances that mirror the original data, typically with the capacity to demonstrate creative and inventive behavior beyond what was explicitly designed.

Dr .Sasikala also discussed about the following Generative AI tools with special and detailed emphasis on how to use ChatGPT.

- > Text Generation tools GPT, Jasper, AI-Writer and Lex
- ➤ Image Generation tools Dall-E 2, Midjourney and Stable diffusion
- ➤ Music generation tools Amper, DadaBots and MuseNet
- ➤ Code generation tools- CodeStarter, Codex, GitHub, Copilot, Tabnine
- ➤ Voice synthesis tools Descript, Listnr, Podcast.ai
- > AI chip design Tools-Synopsys, Cadence, Google and Nvidia.

#### **Outcome of Day 5 FDP:**



Further she explored the importance of Deep learning algorithms, discussed about the importance for AI powered tools, and also reiterated the online research tools in conducting quality research. 


