Report on Guest Lecture: "You Are the Maker of Your Destiny"

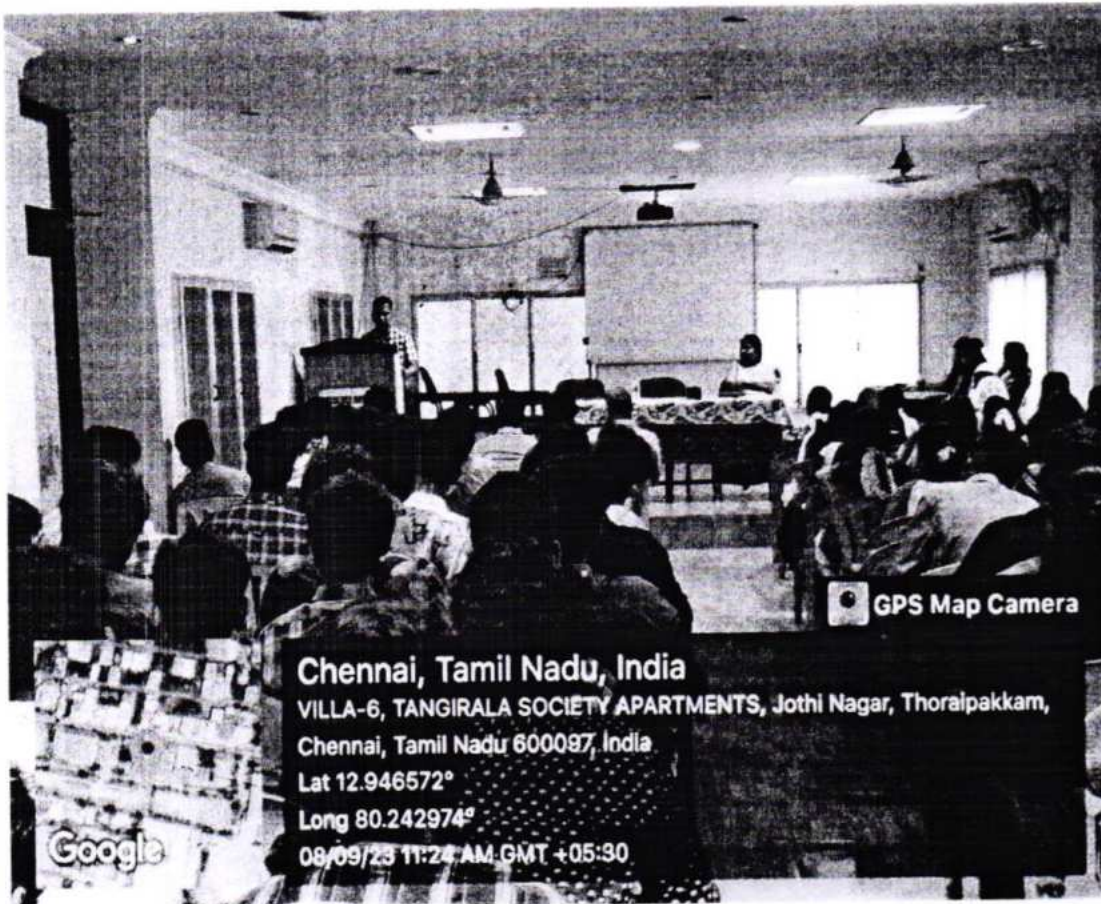
Date: September 8th, 2023

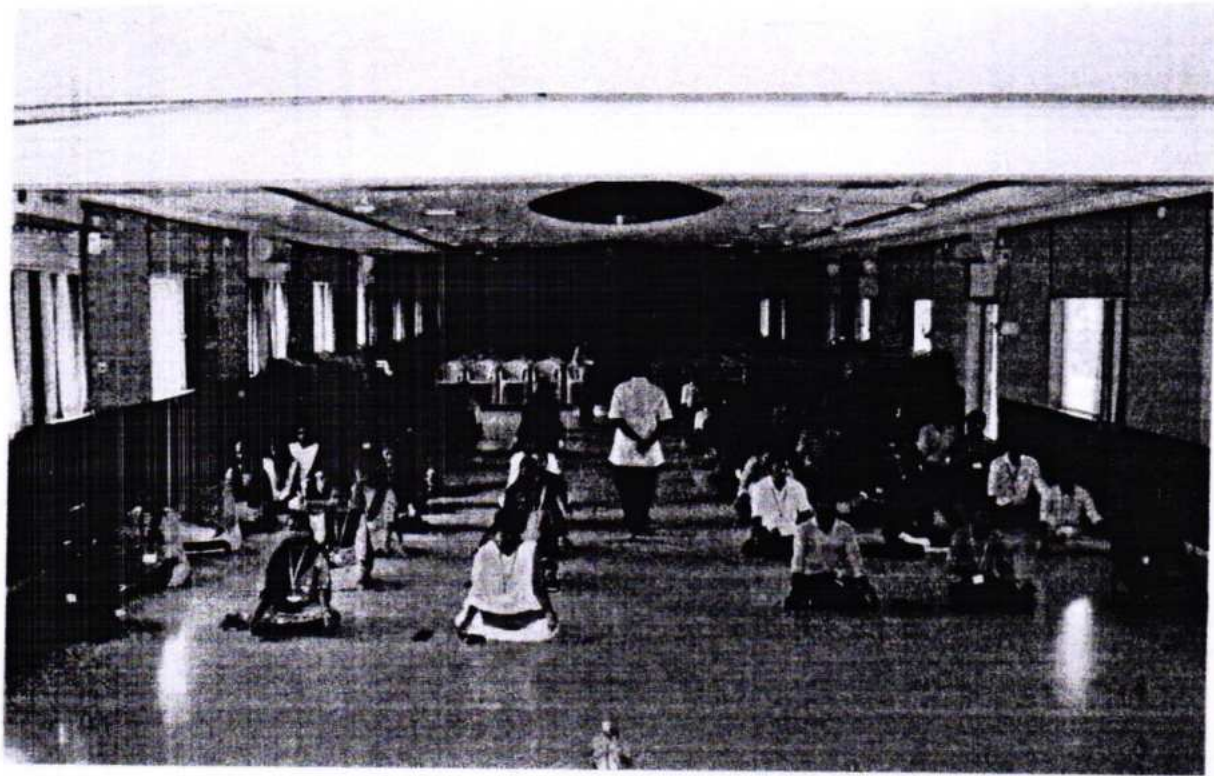

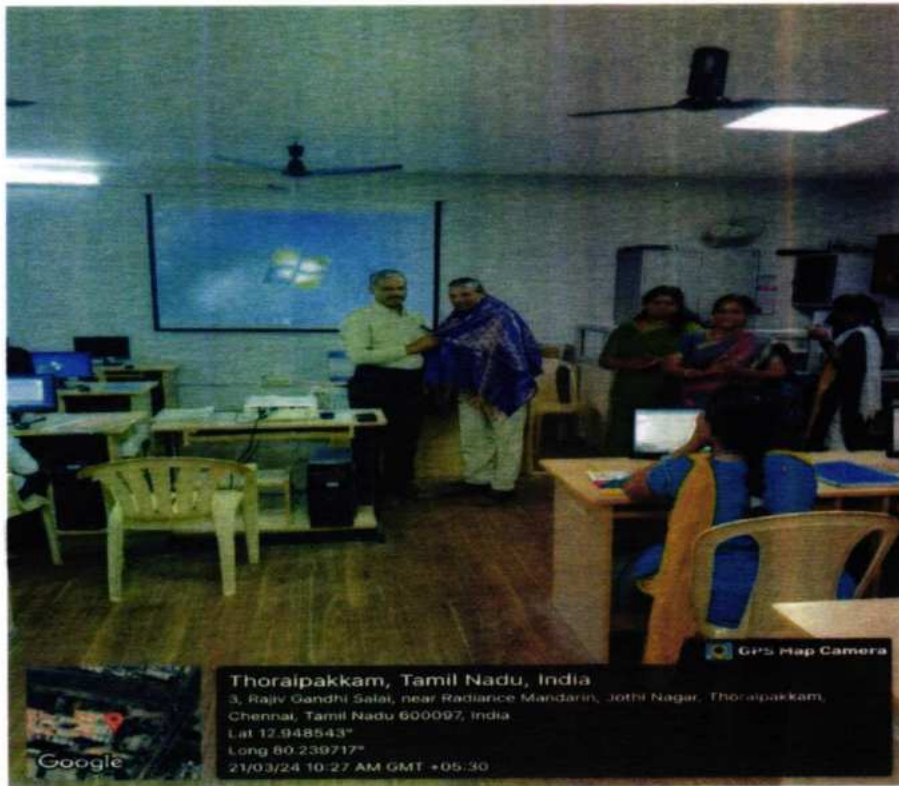
